### PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

Students will be divided into three groups, each supervised by a qualified trainer and assessor in plastering.

Their project will cover the following:

- Building a frame (metal stud and track)
- · Sheeting walls with plasterboard
- Installing a grid ceiling
- · Applying setting to complete joints

The project will be designed to fit within the program timeframe and provide students with a well-rounded introduction to the trade.
